

White Wines

1. Sams Island Colombard Chardonnay, Australia £ 10.50
Soft easy drinking with fresh apple and melon fruit flavours.
2. Corbières Réserve du Sud Cuvée Saint-Laurent, Cave Foncalieu, France £10.50
Crisp, dry white, blended from Clairette and Malvoisie grapes selected from the rugged area of south-west France.
3. Trivento Chardonnay, Torrontes, Argentina £11.50
A beautifully fragrant nose, leads to a palate brimming with light, fresh fruit flavours, dry and refreshing.
4. Chenin Blanc, Kline Zalze, Stellenboch, South Africa £11.50
Soft and easy-drinking using this famous Loire grape, with a green apple flavour and crisp ripe acidity with a little bit of tropical fruit to fill out the flavour.
5. Pinot Grigio Sartori Italy £13.75
Easy drinking, Zesty citrus and grapefruit notes.
7. Sauvignon Blanc, Granfort, VdP d'Oc, France £13.50
Pale yellow core with lime and citrus fruit on the pallet with a smooth elegant finish.
8. Muscadet de Sèvre et Maine Sur Lie, Domaine de la Jousseinière, Gilbert Chon, France £13.00
A fine example of a dry Loire white wine given extra richness by maturation on its lees.
9. Otra Vida Viognier, Argentina £13.80
Rich with Apricot and honey aromas, lively fresh flavour and delicious tropical fruit aftertaste. Delightful.
10. Chardonnay Langhe, Domini Villa Lanata Italy £13.75
A crisp dry wine from North Western Italy. It has a light floral nose with a ripe grapefruit character on the palette lasting following through to a light mineral finish.
11. L'Emage Sauvignon Blanc, France £12.00
Clean, Refreshing Citrus, gooseberry and Mown Grass Character
12. Mâcon Villages Boulay, France £13.75
Attractive fresh chardonnay fruit flavours with a pleasing fresh youthful appeal.
14. Closheim Riesling Natte, Germany £15.75
Elegant, lime and citrus characters.
15. Gavi di Gavi la Toledana, Villa Lanata, Italy £16.00
Pale green-gold colour, delicate floral bouquet and a fresh green gooseberry, mineral palate: dry but not austere, from the central and most sought after zone within the area of Gavi.

Rose Wines

16. Prosecco Rosé, Italy £16.00
Veneto and Friuli are famed for their lightly sparkling wine called Prosecco. Attractive strawberry and forest fruit flavours with a tiny bit of sweetness on the finish.
20. Syrah Rosé, Casablanca Valley, Veramonte, Chile £14.70
This wonderful Syrah rosé smacks of intense strawberry and cherry aromas. It is well balanced with complex flavours of cassis and a crisp refreshing finish.

Red Wines

21. Sams Island Cabernet Shiraz, Australia £10.50
Blackberry aromas and soft dark fruit flavours in an easy drinking style
22. Ropiteau L'Emage Cabernet Sauvignon, France £11.55
Silky smooth red with irresistible blackcurrant aromas
23. Otra Vida Malbec, Argentina £13.75
A rich full bodied wine with ripe fruit and soft tannins with long lingering finish.
24. Santa Carolina Merlot, Chile £12.75
A red and black fruit flavoured wine with after tastes of pepper and spice
25. Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Italy £12.75
Intense ruby red, bouquet reminiscent of violets and oranges and ripe tannic finish
26. Robert Skalli Pinot Noir, VdP Ile de Beauté, France £12.75
Powerful flavours of small black fruit. Secondary flavours of chocolate and liquorish give wonderful depth to this silky wine.
27. Château Tour Grand Mayne, Côtes de Castillon, France £13.70
Clean, ripe berry fruit with well integrated oak make this a soft elegant wine for matching with classic medium flavoured dishes.
29. Stonehaven Cellar Selection Cabernet-Shiraz, Limestone Coast, Australia £14.25
Blackcurrant flavour mixed with chocolate and spice. Red berry fruit and a long, smooth finish.
30. Cotes du Rhône, Les Abeilles Rouge, Jean-Luc Colombo, France £16.00
Seductive nose of berry fruits with hints of coriander and bay leaf.
31. Shiraz, E-Minor, Barossa Valley, Australia £16.00
This has a spicy character with strong blackcurrant and plum fruit flavour.
34. Campo Viejo, Rioja Reserva, Spain £15.50
Spicy, full ripe mature fruit with excellent structure and a gentle, elegant finish.
